Message for February 2018

Dear Friends in Christ;

The Sacrament of Confirmation completes a Catholic's initiation in the Church. Other mainline denominations have Confirmation too, but their Confirmation is not efficacious (as a sacrament) because all the Protestant Churches lack Apostolic Succession. They still have valid sacraments with Baptism and Marriage, but no other. Today, I want you to read from the Catechism to boost your knowledge about the Sacrament. Then I want you to answer some questions and then debate at what age you think a child should be confirmed. Please share your own experience of Confirmation and conclude by praying a litany to the Holy Spirit.

To Christ through Mary;

*Open with Sign of Cross and **Prayer to the Holy Spirit***

L: Come, O Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your faithful, and enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth Your Spirit, O Lord, and they shall be created.

R: And You shall renew the face of the earth

L: Let us pray – God our Father, pour out the gifts of your Holy Spirit on the world. You sent the Spirit on Your Church to begin the teaching of the Gospel; now let the Spirit continue to work in the world through the hearts of all who believe. Through Christ our Lord.

R: Amen

L: You, O Lord, will open my lips.

R: And my tongue shall announce Your praise.

L: Incline unto my aid, O God.

R: O Lord, make haste to help me.

L: Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.

R: As it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be world without end. Amen

Read CCC 1285 “What did Jesus say about the Advocate?”

Read CCC 1287 “Do you in any way think or feel as if you are living in terms of (living in the Messianic Age)? Explain why yes or no?”

Read CCC 1288 “The Laying on of hands happens in what other sacraments?” “Can you lay hands (in prayer) on anyone you would like to pray for? Where does this authority come from?”

Read CCC 1293-4 “Does the act of anointing connect to your life experience in any way?” “So the sacramental sign of oil, could it be replaced with something else” (no right or wrong answer – just a curiosity question)

Read 1303-05

Finally read 1306-1308 and discuss if you think a child should receive Confirmation in elementary school or as an older high school student. Please share your own experience and if it was a meaningful one.
