



#### **Honduras Medical Mission Request**

Hello, My name is Rachel Bridgeford and I have been a member of St. James since I moved to Aitkin in Dec. 2020. I am excited to be part of a medical mission team. going to Rio Viejo, Honduras March 2-9, 2024. Our medical mission team will partner with Healing Hands Global and the Jungle Hospital to bring health, hope and healing to people in the mountains of northern Honduras, home to 20,000 people, many who are living in poor rural areas with very limited access to healthcare. Our team of 22 medical and dental professionals along with interpreters and support staff will minister to people through outreach clinics in Rio Viejo and surrounding villages. Previous teams have provided care to over 400 patients during these clinics. I feel privileged to be able to use my background in nursing to bring the healing love of Jesus to Honduras. Please prayerfully consider contributing financially towards the cost of my trip. Each medical team member must raise \$2,995 which includes a percentage to purchase our medical supplies.
